



City of Hillsboro Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Stations

If you drive an electric vehicle and need to charge up in Hillsboro, the City has installed a total of 35 units; 25 are accessible to the public, including one Level III. The Coulomb units, indicated in green with a "C", are capable of charging vehicles with both Level I (standard) and Level II J-1772 plugs. The Blink units, indicated in blue with a "B", are equipped with Level II J-1772 plugs. The Blink unit indicated in orange with a "B" is equipped with Level III (480 Volt 3-Phase AC input).





CHARGING STATION LOCATIONS

Civic Center, 150 E. Main St, Hillsboro

Five charging stations, two on Main Street and two underneath the building, plus one Level III at the edge of Washington Street.




Intermodal Transit Facility (ITF), 265 SE 8th Ave, Hillsboro

Thirteen charging stations located in the ITF, downtown across from Tuality Hospital. The five stations on the first floor and the two stations on the second floor are accessible to the public and are available 24 hours a day. One space per unit is designated EV only. The remaining six stations on floors three through five are reserved for Pacific University and Tuality staff.

Walters Cultural Arts Center, 527 E. Main St, Hillsboro



Two charging stations are located at the Glenn and Viola Walters Cultural Arts Center downtown. These stations are available 24 hours per day. One space per unit is designated EV only.

Brookwood Library, 2850 NE Brookwood Pkwy, Hillsboro

Four charging stations are located at the Brookwood (Main) Library on NE Brookwood between Cornell Road and Evergreen Parkway behind the building on the north side. One space per unit designated EV only.



Hillsboro Gordon Faber Stadium Complex, 4450 NW 229th Ave, Hillsboro

Three charging stations are located in front of the Hillsboro Stadium near the intersection of US Hwy 26 and Cornelius Pass Road. One space per unit is designated EV only. The stadium facility is open during the many frequent events hosted there and is generally accessible through Gate A or Gate B between 8AM and 7PM weekdays and weekends.

Parks & Recreation Administrative Office, 4400 NW 229th Ave, Hillsboro

One charging station is located behind the building and is open during business hours, weekend days and during larger events at the stadium.

Jackson Bottom North Viewing Area, 996 S 1st Ave, Hillsboro

Two charging stations are available 24 hours per day, one space per unit is designated EV only.
