

Glencoe Swale Study – Letter of Map Revision (LOMR)

Location: Flood plain along Glencoe Swale

About

Through the process of evaluating frequent flooding problems in the Glencoe Swale drainage, it was discovered that improved data and hydrologic information for Glencoe Swale results in a reduction in the 100-year water surface elevation.

The reduced water surface elevation could translate into: reduced flood inundation, reduced flood risk, and a reduction in the number of private properties required to purchase flood insurance. Revisions to flood insurance first require a Letter of Map Revision (LOMR).

Project Funding Sources

This project was funded by the Surface Water Management (SWM) Depreciation, SWM System Development Charges (SDC), and the SWM Local Service Fee (LSF).
