## Proposed Rates. Effective July 1, 2015.

**Sanitary sewer rates are proposed to increase \$1.19 (3%) a month for the average household. The Surface Water Management fee is proposed to increase 50¢ (7.4%) per month for the average household.** These proposed increases will take effect July 1, 2015, and will be shared proportionately between Clean Water Services and its member cities. The increases are necessary to meet stringent federal water quality requirements, and to upgrade and maintain the community's wastewater collection and treatment facilities.
